Remember the movie *A Few Good Men*? The character of defense counsel, Daniel Kaffee (played by Tom Cruise), was based on this year's Law Day speaker, Captain David Iglesias, JAGC, U. S. Navy. Captain Iglesias left active duty in 1988 but continued his career in public service and in 2001 was named United States Attorney for the District of New Mexico. He served in that position until 2007 when he became one of the U. S. Attorneys fired by the Bush Administration. As a member of the U. S. Navy Reserve Judge Advocate General's Corp, he was recently reactivated as part of a special prosecution team for detainees at Guantanamo Bay. Captain Iglesias will be drawing on his personal experiences for his Law Day presentation.
